Missionary Orders There will be a retiring collection today for the Missionary Orders for the Annual Mission Appeal.

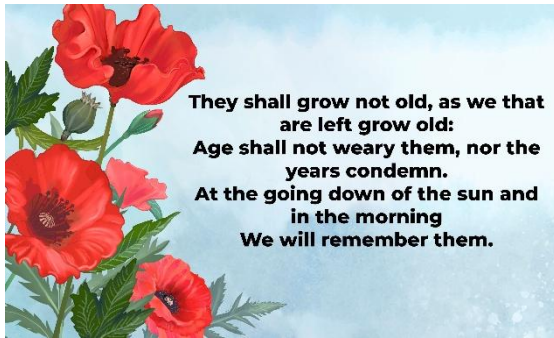
For the sick
