**ROSARY** every Wednesday morning at 10.30am and evening at 7pm at Plympton.

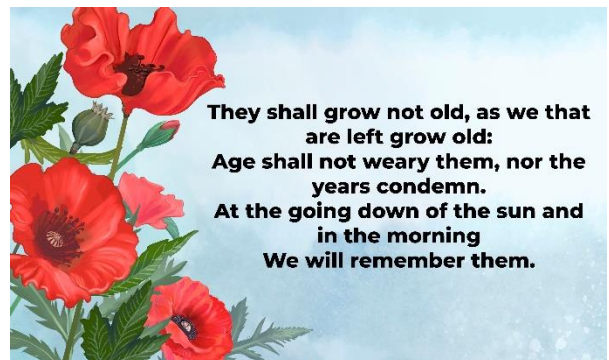
#### **For the sick**
