[Pilgrimage to Launceston – The National Shrine of St Cuthbert Mayne](#)

31 'pilgrims of hope' journeyed from the different parishes of the Plymouth East Roman Catholic churches to the national shrine of St Cuthbert Mayne in Launceston on Saturday 22nd November.

The day started with Holy Mass and after refreshments in the parish Hall we listened to an informative talk by Canon John Deeny about St Cuthbert Mayne's life and martyrdom. After having a personal moment to venerate his relic we then enjoyed our lunch back in the parish hall where the local parishioners shared their hospitality with us.

After lunch we visited places of interest in Launceston itself associated with the imprisonment, trial and execution of the Saint. We offered prayers for the conversion of our country and world, including prayers for more Priests to serve our churches.

We finished with a visit to the beautiful Anglican church of St Mary Magdalene and joined in with the local custom of stone

throwing over our shoulders on to a prostrate statue of St Mary Magdalene. Two of our parishioners successfully landed their stone and, according to tradition, can now expect a silk dress at Easter!

In the words of St Cuthbert Mayne 'Manus Tuas Domine' - Into your hands O Lord. We asked for his intercession for us all in our four churches and we look forward to our next journey together.
